Employment Training Programs

All NSITE programs are delivered virtually and are adapted to accommodate blind and low-vision learners.

Professional Master of Office Technology for Employment (ProMOTE)

Gain advanced assistive technology training using the most common office software programs – Microsoft Word, Excel, and PowerPoint – as well as instruction in internet research and creating accessible documents. The program inspires success by using an innovative approach to serve job seekers of all ages by focusing on individualized strategies customized for their needs.

Contract Management Support Basic Courses

Through a unique partnership with the Defense Acquisition University, NSITE provides the technical training and skills needed for career opportunities in contract administration. Participants will learn principles that are foundational for contract management, and graduates will qualify for a variety of contract management support positions.

Contract Management Support 101 Cohort

This virtually instructor-led advanced training program provides people who are blind with the technical skills needed for high-growth career opportunities in contract administration to fulfill a critical need for qualified specialists to close-out executed government contracts.

Cisco Academy

Prepare for a Cisco Certified Network Associate (CCNA) credential, learning information technology (IT) and cybersecurity fundamentals. The coursework is adapted to accommodate the learning styles of people who are blind, low vision, or visually impaired. We provide career coaching from resume writing and mock interviews, to professional networking and workplace etiquette. Programs that are part of the Cisco Academy include:

- NSITE Cisco Certified Network Associate (CCNA)
- NSITE CCST: Networking Cisco Certified Support Technician (CCST): Networking
- Other IT Programs offered: CISCO Cybersecurity and Intro to Cybersecurity

Sourcing Certification

NSITE partners with Social Talent and Bristol Myers Squibb to offer 18 weeks of cohort-based learning that includes a 6-week practical work experience within a corporate talent acquisition team. After successful completion, participants earn the NSITE Sourcing Specialist digital credential

Business Leaders Program

This series of tailored courses offers the chance to build business acumen and leadership and management skills. This award-winning program was launched in 2003 to provide professional development opportunities for individuals who are blind or visually impaired.

It offers five professional development tracks: Business Basics, Business Essentials, Effective Supervision, Executive Leadership Development Program

Google Certificates

Explore an array of learning paths through NSITE's partnership with Google, including Google Project Management, Google Data Analytics, Google Digital Marketing and E-Commerce, Google IT Support, Google Cybersecurity Essentials, Google Al and more.

Employment Opportunities
